Return to Play Protocols

- Anyone (spectators, players, coaches, etc.) not on the field of play must maintain six (6) feet of physical distance between themselves and others (excluding members of the same household) OR wear a mask.
- Drills and activities will be organized to limit player to player contact during training sessions.
- No one will be allowed to share any gear including water bottles, shin guards, balls, cleats etc.
- Pinnies (if needed) will be issued to players and they will be responsible for them as personal gear.
- All personal gear must be washed in between practices.
- Limit carpooling to and from practices.
- Unnecessary physical contact must be avoided (e.g. hugs, high fives, handshakes, etc.)
- Only coaches will be handling equipment such as ball bags, cones, and flags throughout the duration of practice.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be made available during practices.
- Each player is allowed two (2) spectators per event (practice, game, etc.)
- Coaches must fill out the practice log at each practice so that we can track player interactions in a scenario where someone becomes ill.
- Any player who has been ill (COVID or other) or has a member of their household who has been ill (COVID or other) in the last 14 days is prohibited from participating.
- We recommend avoiding use of the outhouses if possible. Those facilities are maintained by Flathead County Parks and Rec and NOT by Bigfork Soccer Club
- All participation in BSC activities is completely voluntary.
